## Call for Applications

The Abba Eban Institute for International Diplomacy offers an annual internship program **for passionate students who are considering a career in diplomacy, international relations, and their intersection with the media.** Over the course of the 2021-22 academic year, interns will have the opportunity to deepen their understanding of foreign policy and get an insider's view of international diplomacy.

### Mission Statement & Professional Approach

The Abba Eban Institute is a **proactive research center** working to study, theorize, and help craft **an innovative, practical, and effective diplomatic infrastructure for the State of Israel.** The Institute's ultimate aim is to strengthen Israel's international relations and diplomatic influence through proactive action.

### Internship Accreditation

Students can choose to take the internship for **2 academic credits** (subject to approval by their academic track coordinators, and only if they have not previously completed an accredited internship). Alternatively, they can apply to take it as a non-credit internship.

# Internship Opportunities

## The Policy and Technology Program

Interns will assist in conducting policy- and action-oriented research, and take part in proactive diplomatic campaigns.

## The Asia-Israel Policy Program

Interns will assist in conducting policy-oriented research, strategic assessments and network building with our Asian partners.

## The Diplomacy 2030 Program

Interns will cover policy-oriented research on Innovative Diplomacy while assisting on various projects.

## The Israel - Arab Gulf Program (IAGP)

Interns will help promote economic, cultural, and political relations with key actors in the Arab Gulf region, following the signing of the Abraham Accords.

## “The Arena” Magazine

Interns will assist in critiquing, editing, and copywriting articles, uploading content to the magazine’s website, and expanding the magazine’s presence online.

## The Media Operations Department

Interns will gather and analyze information for use in our press activities and online publications, and help create content for new media operations.

# Requirements & Submission Guidelines

## General requirements:

- Registered undergraduate students (2nd and 3rd year) or graduate students from all IDC schools
- Excellent research skills
- Fluent English (several placements will be reserved for native Hebrew speakers)
- Commitment to 6-8 weekly work hours (approx. 120-140 hours annual)
- Mandatory participation in all group meetings and workshops during the year

## Specific requirements for “The Arena” magazine:

- Media and journalistic affinity (previous experience is an advantage)
- Passion for academic, journalistic, and/or literary editing and copywriting
- Deep knowledge and understanding of current affairs, global trends, and international diplomacy

## Specific requirements for The Israel - Arab Gulf Program (IAGP):

- Economic/financial background; Qualitative research experience
- Fluent Arabic (desired, but not compulsory)

Candidates must upload their CV and a short cover letter as well as an academic writing sample in English, using the link below. **The deadline for applications is Wednesday, October 20th, 2021, at 23:00.**
