Application Information

Dear internship candidate,

Thank you for your interest in the Abba Eban Institute's internship programs. We are always excited to enlist brilliant and motivated young talent from Israel and abroad, the academics and professionals of tomorrow. Our interns take part in all the Institute's activities, and we consider them an integral part of our team.

Our internship application process consists of two stages: a general assessment of your professional career and relevant skills, which – if you are found suitable – is followed by an interview with our staff.

For the first stage, we ask that you send us the following documents:

- An updated CV detailing your academic studies, professional experience, and fields of interest which best correspond with the Institute's activities (if applicable).
- A cover letter explaining your academic and/or professional ambitions and interests. The letter should also detail how you think an internship with us can help advance your goals, and what you believe you can contribute to our activities.
- An academic writing sample, which helps us assess your research and writing skills. Preferably, this would be an essay written in our fields of activity; however, if you do not have one, you can submit what you consider your best academic essay.

Candidates who are found suitable will then be invited for a half-hour interview (in English) with the Institute's staff. To best prepare for this stage, we encourage you to:

- Read [former interns' testimonials](#) and learn about the work of an intern at the Institute.
- Carefully consider which program you would wish to join, how you can fit into its activities, and what you can contribute.
- Follow the news and remain up to date with major current affairs and events in international relations and geopolitics.

Successful candidates will be offered a position in one of our programs, based on availability, the Institute's needs, the candidate's skills and experience, and their personal interests.
